Employment Opportunities

We require staffing for the following weeks of camp:

Beginnin’ Camp – Boys and Girls ages 5-7: Junior and Senior Trekin’ Camp - Boys and Girls ages 8-13:

Explorin’ Camp – Boys and Girls ages 11-15: Trailblazin’ Camp - Boys and Girls ages 13-15

Minimum age to work at Trekin’ and Explorin’ Camp is 14 years old. These positions would include maintenance, housekeeping and dining hall duties. Cabin Leader positions begin at 16 years old. Trailblazin’ Camp staff must be 16 years old.

All student staff are required to work for a minimum of 2 weeks in July (not including pre-camp) and 1 week in August. Those students applying for additional weeks will receive first consideration.

Pre-qualifications

- A sample list of duties and responsibilities is available upon request. Your specific duties will be assigned to you during our pre-camp training.
- **It is mandatory that all staff are required to attend the entire pre-camp** training usually during the first week of July. (Adult staff unable to attend the full week of pre-camp will be required to attend a minimum one of two specific evenings of orientation just after July 1st and a full Saturday orientation session in June.)
- You are required to complete, in full, the camp application form and return it to the camp address above.

Compensation and Benefits

Volunteer

As a registered non-profit organization, we appreciate all who can volunteer their time in giving leadership at Mill Stream without compensation. This helps us in compensating college students and others who need income from summer employment. Please indicate on the application form if you are volunteering your time without need of compensation.

Compensated Staff

As a staff member of Mill Stream you will receive a “per week” compensation for the weeks you serve the Lord at camp. This is subject to change as our needs change based on camper registration, staff positions being fulfilled satisfactorily and as funds are available. You will also have the option of participating in our Summer Missionary Assistance Fund. Compensation and support level information is available on our Summer Staff Financial Programs Information sheet. You can receive a copy of this program information by contacting us at the office via email, phone or fax.

Adult Staff

Adult staff is accepted as needed to fulfill some leadership, elective and support roles. These positions are on a non-compensated volunteer basis. Please note that do to the volume of requests we receive, you may be asked to fulfill a different position than what you have applied for and possibly during a different week that you have requested.

Adults who have children wanting to attend the same week are subject to the following guidelines:

- 1) Children must be of appropriate camper age and be involved in the full-time program for the week you are serving (we do not provide child care services).
- 2) In recognition of your non-compensated service, your 1st child would attend for free, 2nd child is at ½ the weekly rate, 3rd and all additional children are at full rate.
